## **How to Separate and Dispose Garbage**

- ◆Please put garbage at the Garbage Collection Sites in the morning by 8:30 am on the collection days.
- ◆DON'T put garbage at the Garbage Collection Sites during non-collection days as well as the nights before collection days.

Burnable Garbage	•Kitchen wastes, plastics (toys and other containers), paper diapers, leather goods, Styrofoam, CDs and DVDs	<ul> <li>Put in designated blue garbage bags.</li> <li>Soak up cooking oil with papers or cloths before disposing.</li> </ul>
Every week ondayday	•Small tree branches	<ul><li>NOT put in designated blue garbage bags.</li><li>Cut into shorter than 50 cm.</li><li>Tie up in a bundle of NOT wider than 30cm.</li></ul>
Non-burnable Garbage	•Broken glasses, ceramic wares (bowls, dishes, flower pots, cosmetic bottles), kettles, pans, light bulbs	• Put in designated non-colored transparent garbage bags.

Recyclable Items  Every month on theth and thethday  Batteries 3 times a year onth	•Glass bottles (beer, juice, sake, whisky, seasoning) •PET bottles •Cans •Spray cans, Gas cartridges •Clothes •Newspapers •Books and magazines •Cardboards •Other papers boxes, bags and wrappings  •Dry cell batteries (manganese, alkali, oxyride, and lithium batteries)	*Remove caps and wash inside. Large-Size Items Every month on thethday	•Stereos, radios, electric fans, vacuum cleaners, rice cookers, microwave ovens, bicycles, carpets, beddings, fluorescent tubes	<ul> <li>The maximum weight is 20 kg.</li> <li>The size must be no bigger than one person can carry.</li> <li>Carpets must be rolled and tied.</li> <li>Beddings must be folded and tied.</li> <li>Bicycles must be clearly labeled as "ごみ (Gomi)".</li> <li>※Items subject to Home Appliance Recycling Law (TVs, Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditionings, Washing machines, Clothes driers) are NOT allowed to be put at garbage collection sites.</li> </ul>
